




DECLARATION OF ACCEPTANCE OF OFFICE

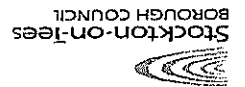

FORM A NOTES

FORM A NOTES TO REGISTER OF DISCLOSEABLE PECUNIARY INTERESTS

You should complete the registration form with sufficient detail to identify clearly what the interest is. Please do not use abbreviations, initials or acronyms. You are personally responsible for the accuracy of the contents of your register entry. This entry should include details of your discloseable pecuniary interests and the discloseable pecuniary interests of your partner (which means spouse or civil partner, a person with whom you are living as husband and wife, or a person with whom you are living as if you are civil partners).

The descriptions of the interests are subject to the following definitions:-

“the Act” means the Localism Act 2011;

“body in which the relevant person has a beneficial interest” means a firm in which the relevant person is a partner or a body corporate of which the relevant person is a director, or in the securities of which the relevant person has a beneficial interest;

“director” includes member of the committee of management of an industrial and provident society;

“land” includes an easement, servitude, interest or right in or over land which does not carry with it a right for the relevant person (alone or jointly with another) to occupy the land or to receive income;

“M” means the person M referred to in section 30 of the Act (in practice this is the Member or person referred to as “you” in this note);

“member” includes a co-opted member;

“relevant authority” means the authority of which M is a member;

“relevant period” means the period of 12 months ending with the day on which M gives a notification for the purposes of section 30(1) or section 31(7), as the case may be, of the Act (a notification to the Monitoring Officer of any discloseable pecuniary interests which the member giving the notice has at the time the notification is given);

“relevant person” means M or any other person referred to in section 30(3)(b) of the Act (M’s spouse or civil partner etc);

“securities” means shares, debentures, debenture stock, loan stock, bonds, units of a collective investment scheme within the meaning of the Financial Services and Markets Act 2000 and other securities of any description, other than money deposited with a building society.

Register of Interests

Any interests notified to the Borough Council's Monitoring Officer will be included in the register of interests which the Monitoring Officer maintains.

A copy of the register will be available for public inspection and will be published on the Borough Council's website and any on any website maintained by the Town/Parish Council concerned.

Sensitive Interests

Where you consider that disclosure of the details of a disclosable pecuniary interest (or any other registrable interest under the Code of Conduct) could lead to you, or a person connected to you, being subject to violence or intimidation, and the Borough Council's Monitoring Officer agrees, if the interest is entered on the register, copies of the register that are made available for inspection and any published version of the register will exclude details of the interest, but may state that you have a (disclosable pecuniary) interest, the details of which are withheld under Section 32(2) of the Act.

Dispositions

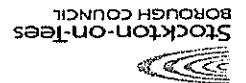
The Town/Parish Council (through the Clerk as Proper Officer) may grant you a dispensation, but only in limited circumstances, to enable you to participate and vote on a matter in which you have a disclosable pecuniary interest. Separate guidance is available regarding dispensations. Please contact the Proper Officer for further information.

Offences

It is a criminal offence:-

- to fail to notify the Borough Council's Monitoring Officer of any disclosable pecuniary interest within 28 days of election;
- to fail to disclose a disclosable pecuniary interest at a meeting if it is not already on the register of interests;
- to fail to notify the Borough Council's Monitoring Officer within 28 days, of a disclosable pecuniary interest that is not on the register and which you have disclosed to a meeting;
- to participate in any discussion or vote on a matter in which you have a disclosable pecuniary interest (and where you have not been granted an appropriate dispensation);
- knowing or recklessly to provide information that is false or misleading in notifying the Borough Council's Monitoring Officer of a disclosable pecuniary interest or in disclosing such an interest to a meeting.

The criminal penalties available to a court are to impose a fine not exceeding level 5 (£5,000) on the standard scale and disqualification from being a councillor for up to 5 years.

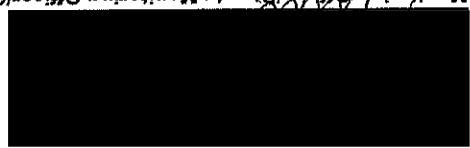
